## Oakengates Children's Centre @ The Wakes

Telford & Wrekin Council agreed budget saving proposals for our Children Centre Services which would see a reduction in the Council's input into children Centres. As a result, Children Centre Services have been actively working with partner organisations, individuals and community groups seeking alternative delivery.

Oakengates Town Council was approached by Telford & Wrekin Children Centre Services to discuss the impact on the local community within the Oakengates and St Georges areas. Following discussions, Oakengates Town Council expressed an interest to enable the Children Centre registered building to be at The Wakes and also agreed to develop new provision for children and families.

Following a successful consultation, it was agreed that The Wakes will make a fabulous venue. This means that current group activities will move to The Wakes in January 2019, creating more opportunities for early year's provision in the area. Look out for future news and a launch date!
